The papers and abstract should be submitted in the prescribed format on [e-mail seminar.pihani@gmail.com](mailto:seminar.pihani@gmail.com). The paper should be within 3000 words including abstract. The abstract should not exceed 300 words and should include title, background, objectives, methodology and findings/results. The contributor(s) should kindly provide their name/s, affiliation, mailing address, e-mail and phone number along with the abstract. The papers are acceptable both in English and Hindi. The paper must be typed in the Times New Roman and Unicode font. The font shall be in the size of 12 with 1.5 line spacing and footnotes of size 10. The same style of citations should be strictly followed throughout the paper. For poster presentation 1meter x 1meter space will be provided for each poster. Poster should be preferably on flex sheets.

All the accepted research papers/abstracts will be eligible for presentation and the presenters/corresponding authors must get registered on or before the final registration deadline. **The selected full length papers will be published in online peer reviewed Journals and also in edited book with ISBN.** The papers received after stipulated deadline shall not be entertained for publication but allowed for presentation in the conference.
